All funds raised from your participation in the York 10k 2022 should be paid to York Mind in £ sterling. Although you have been given a minimum fundraising target, the aim is for you to raise as much as possible!

Entry Process

1. Participant signs up online via Beacon. In doing so, you **agree to the terms and conditions outlined in this document.**
2. Once complete, the participant will receive communication from a member of York Mind staff with next steps. The participant will also receive a fundraising pack & monthly emails until the date of the race.

Withdrawal policy

- If you withdraw your entry, **please let us know as soon as possible.**
- If you withdraw from the race and have already raised funds you must offer to return them to your sponsors and if they do not wish for a refund then you must pay them to York Mind.

All participants:

- You confirm that you are medically fit and that you participate in the event at your own risk. York Mind will not be held responsible for injury or illness resulting from your participation.
- You understand that it is your responsibility to read any terms and conditions issued by the race organisers and to comply with these.
- The minimum age for this event is 16. You confirm you will be the minimum age on race day.
- You acknowledge that York Mind incur costs as a result of you joining Team York Mind (e.g. cost of you entry place, producing and sending fundraising pack) for this challenge. The objective is for you to raise as much sponsorship as possible.
- Should you, for whatever reason, not take part in the race, all sponsorship raised must be offered in return to your sponsors, if they do not want a refund then forwarded to York Mind as a donation.

- You have provided York Mind information about you and consent to York Mind using this data. You understand that it will be necessary for York Mind to share the data with the race organisers in order to participate in this event.
- York Mind do not sell or swap your details with any third parties, but in order to carry out our work we may need to pass your details to service companies authorised to act on our behalf.
- York Mind will keep your details on our database so we can provide you with the best possible support every time you contact us.
- All participants, supporters and spectators, including friends and families who choose to attend the event confirm that they are happy for their names, video footage, photographs taken of them during the event to be used to publicise the event by York Mind for commercial and fundraising purposes including, but not limited to marketing material, television broadcasts, social media, advertising, publications, and other documents or mediums that may be made available to the public. Photographs of children will not be used in this manner without express written consent; unless the images are incidental, for example, children's images at the starting line.
